A DAY TRIP TO VISIT THE FIRST OFFSHORE OIL RIG AND A VISIT TO THE WEDELL-WILLIAMS AVIATION AND CYPRESS SAWMILL MUSEUMS



The International Petroleum Museum- "Mr. Charlie"

Visit the first offshore submersible transportable drilling rig in the United States. Located in the Atchafalaya River in Morgan City, it was first built in 1953 and served as a drilling platform for offshore drilling from 1956 until 1984. A guide will explain what it was like to work and live offshore 7-14 days at a time. Visit a real drilling rig and walk in the steps of roustabouts, roughnecks, and drillers.

After our rig tour, we will visit Morgan City where we can walk the 21-foot wall that protects the city from flooding. We will eat at a typical South Louisiana cafe and then take a short drive to Patterson, Louisiana, to visit the **Wedell-Williams Aviation and Cypress Sawmill Museums**. Jimmie Wedell and Harry Williams were nationally prominent during the "Golden Age of Aviation" and formed an air service in Patterson in 1928. Patterson, LA was also once home to the largest cypress sawmill operation in the world!

Plan to leave in the morning on Saturday. We will tour Mr. Charlie beginning at 10 am and the tour should last 1.5 hours. We will eat and then tour the two museums. We may have a little lagniappe for you on the way back through Pierre Part, Louisiana.

No open toe shoes and we will be climbing steel grated stairs. Tour will not take place if it is raining.

OCTOBER 29, SATURDAY SCHEDULE

Cost of the Mr. Charlie Tour is \$5.00 per person. You can pay me while waiting for the tour. The lunch at Boiling Madd should be no more than \$15.00 including tip and you will pay the waitress.

This is a perfect trip to bring wives, children 10 years and older, and friends. If you know someone whom you think would like to know more about Louisiana invite them.

For those who would like to carpool or travel together we will meet at **St. Paul Lutheran Church in the parking lot at 8am and leave promptly at 8:15am.** St. Paul Lutheran Church is located on the corner of Tara Blvd. and Old Hammond Hwy.

We will take I10 south down to I10Exit 182 toward Donaldsonville, right on LA22 and then left on LA70 at the Cajun Village.

We will follow LA 70 until we get to Morgan City. **ONCE IN MORGAN CITY PLEASE SEE ACCOMPANYING MAP FOR RIG LOCATION.**

On LA70 and past the intersection with LA1 we will pass **Bayou Corne** where a collapsed underground salt dome sinkhole was formed in August 2012 and 312 residents were advised to evacuate. A lawsuit concerning the sinkhole is ongoing. This area in South Louisiana is the site of numerous salt domes with some being used for strategic petroleum storage by the federal government.

Pierre Part is home to the Swamp People for those who watch reality TV shows.

As we turn left at **Belle River** notice the Atchafalaya Basin levee on your right and the retaining flood wall on top of the levee. On the other side is what is called the Atchafalaya Basin which is one of the largest drainage basins in the U.S. Some of the best crawfish is said to come from this area.

10AM: Our first stop will be the International Petroleum Exhibition (Mr. Charlie) and the physical address is:

Rig Museum 111 1st. St. Morgan City, LA 70380

The Rig Tour begins at 10AM and lasts between 1 hour and 1.5 hours depending upon the asked questions.

After the tour we will have a short discussion about the repeater operating on "Mr. Charlie".

After the repeater discussion we will proceed to Front St. and park just after Frerer St. to view the 21ft Floor Wall which protects Morgan City from flooding.

We will then proceed to have lunch at **Boiling Madd Cafe** located at 400 Hwy 90 West in Patterson, LA. Their phone number is 985-395-4629. GPS may not give the exact location but it is directly across from the Word of Life Family Church which will be on your immediate left. Boiling Madd Cafe is located in a one story red brick building located at least 100 ft from the road on your right. Attached is the menu for Boiling Madd. Lunch should cost no more than \$15.00 including tip.

After lunch we will visit the **Wedell-Williams Aviation and Cypress Sawmill Museum** which are located in the same building.

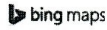
Physical Address is 118 Cotton Rd., Patterson, LA 70392.

The museum is located in the Kemper-Williams Park and has an F4 aircraft positioned just in front of the museum. You will have to make a u-turn on Hwy 90 after you exit the Cafe. The entrance to the Museum is located just east of the museum building and just follow the directions to the museum.

We will watch a short, interesting, and informative video on the early years of cypress logging (late 1800s and early 1900s) and after viewing some of the early logging equipment we will make our way to the Aviation part of the museum.

The aviation part of the museum has a special effects seating arena where multiple screens, wind, sound, and moving chairs all enhance the learning experience about Louisiana's early aviation pioneers.

Depending upon your interest you can expect to leave Patterson, LA no later than 2:30pm and you should be home by 4:30pm.
