Veterans Day USS Kidd W5KID Special Event

Our station operation included 9 operators / loggers during the day: Jen (K5NMT), Don (KF5OHZ), Cory (KG5QCU), Thornton (K5HLC), Jon (WA9JBR), Charlie (KG5VTE), Justin (KE5BUD), Robin (KK5RH), John (WA5MLF). We made a total of 15 contacts -- 12 phone, 3 CW.

When Jen arrived at 10 am we checked for activity on 40 m and 20 m phone. Although we could hear stations on both bands, we found that on 40 m it was not possible to tune better than 6:1 SWR. Jen used 20 m where we could get 2:1 or 1.5:1 SWR, depending on frequency. She called CQ many times and did not get a response. Later, while Don (was operating, we continued on 20 m, still having a hard time being heard.

Our first contact (at 1104 CST) was with NJ2BB (Battleship New Jersey), in response to their CQ. Later, when Jon arrived and posted our operating frequency on a DX Spot site, we got a bunch of responses to our CQs. A little later Jon and Charlie switched to CW (still on 20 m). They made several contacts, but could not stay much past 2 pm. Back on 20 m SSB we made scattered contacts, getting a few more responses. Around 3 pm only Robin and I were left and I put out a bunch of CQs. I made 3 contacts, including Michigan, Puerto Rico and Alabama. I was calling CQ and the strong Michigan station tuned up in our audio passband and then started calling CQ 1 kHz above our frequency! I moved up there and answered his CQ, making the contact.
