The ARRL has made a temporary rule change for this year which will allow home stations operating on commercial power (Class 1D) to be able to work other home stations and still receive credit. This has not been allowed in the past. I am disappointed that the club will not be able to hold a public gathering this year but I understand the concerns of spreading the virus.
