

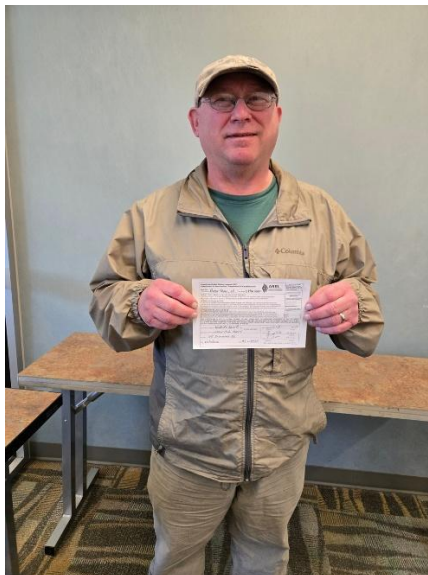


Four Candidates Test for Licenses
